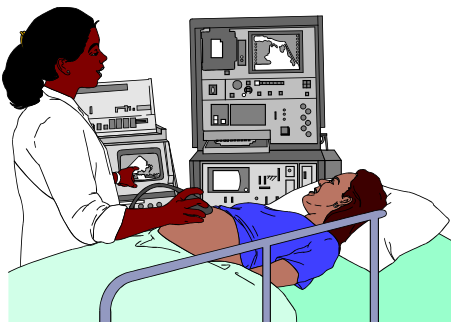
You need to know about Arizona's participation in the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE) Professional Student Exchange Program.

The Arizona Board of Regents WICHE-Professional Student Exchange Program enables Arizona students to enroll in professional programs in other states, or at in-state private institutions, since these programs are not available at Arizona's public universities. Arizona pays a support fee to the school receiving the student to help cover the cost of education. The student pays the difference between the WICHE support fee and standard tuition at the enrolling school.
