The plan is to move current students to the new BAS in Applied science with a concentration in Aviation immediately as this designation on their diploma will enable them to secure more appropriate professional employment opportunities. We would like to have newly admitted students moved to the new concentration in Aviation. Students will be notified via asu.edu email regarding the change. Also, all faculty teaching in the BAS Aviation program will discuss the change in their courses. In addition, a town hall meeting will be held with the students before the end of the spring semester. Incoming students will be emailed, and sent a letter via USPS regarding the changes.
