Briefly describe the proposed change and rationale for the change:

The name change more accurately describes the curriculum and goals of the students in this concentration. Due to the base degree's more business-oriented curriculum beyond the concentration's pre-vet courses, students who plan to establish a private veterinary practice have a different but better preparation than most pre-vet undergraduate degrees. Testimony from practicing veterinarians supports the importance of a strong business background in pre-veterinary studies. The new name will be very helpful in recruiting and successful placement of graduates in veterinary schools.

Discuss the impact of this change on current students and/or enrollment:

No negative impact on current students. In fact, the change should assist current concentration students in their application to veterinary schools by clearly identifying a focused pre-vet curriculum. An accurately named concentration will enable better marketing and thus attact more students to the program.
