Briefly describe the rationale for disestablishment:

The purpose of this request is to formally disestablish the BAE in Early Childhood Teaching and Leadership program. In spring 2009, all undergraduate Teacher Education programs at ASU were merged under the College of Teacher Education and Leadership, renamed the Mary Lou Fulton Teachers College in May 2010. The requirements for the BAE in Early Childhood Education Teaching and Leadership offered at the West Campus and the BAE in Early Childhood Education offered on-line and at the Tempe and Polytechnic campuses were aligned and having two names for the same program caused confusion. The BAE in Early Childhood Education was the preferred name and is now offered on all ASU campuses and on-line. Thus, the BAE in Early Childhood Teaching and Leadership degree program originally approved for the West campus is no longer needed in the ASU academic program inventory.

Impact on other existing programs: Could include availability of course content for students in other majors who may need it; other.

There is no impact on other existing programs.

Impact on current students: Estimate number of students still enrolled; anticipated date of last graduates; arrangements for continuing students and students in articulated transfer pathways (ex. MAPP, TAG).

Since fall 2009, new students have been admitted under the BAE in Early Childhood Education. Approximately 60 students active under the Early Childhood Teaching and Leadership program in fall 2010 will be allowed to graduate under the old name.
