SUBJECT: Proposal to Disestablish the Quality Analysis Certificate


The Quality Analysis Certificate was offered beginning Fall 1994. Since that time, enrollments have been modest with most recent graduation numbers of:

2005-06:	13
2004-05:	21
2003-04:	13
2002-03:	25
2001-02:	22

The certificate has been offered as an interdisciplinary curriculum with no departmental ownership. Faculty responsibility and advising has moved among economics, management, and supply chain management. At this time, there is no faculty ownership nor has any department expressed an interest in continuing the program. Therefore, we propose to disestablish the Quality Analysis Certificate effective Fall 2008.
