## Briefly describe the rationale for disestablishment:

Without a home in a school, this program provides a less than ideal experience for students, and has no faculty who truly mentor or guide either the curriculum or the student population. Additionally, it is in direct competition with the BS Environmental Design, located in The Design School, which is a much more appropriate home for these students both in terms of curriculum and in terms of mentorship.

There are 195 students in the Design Management concentration, with only 3 FTFTF students in this and the parent degree combined. We expect the last graduates in 5 years at most. As the degree is built entirely out of coursework offered by various units (not specifically for these students), we will easily be able to teach out the program. I will continue to fund coursework that serves these students until all students have completed their majors, and this should ensure that any students in an MAPP can complete their degree program in a timely fashion.
