### Briefly describe the rationale for disestablishment:

The certificate in East Asian Studies duplicates what is offered by the certificate in Asian Studies; students can accomplish the same objectives and complete the same courses through the Asian Studies certificate, but the Asian Studies certificate offers even more course choices. In addition, both the East Asian Studies certificate and the Asian Studies certificate have had low enrollment, so maintaining only one of these two certificates reduces the administrative efforts needed.

### Impact on other existing programs:

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#### Impact on current students:
