Briefly describe the rationale for disestablishment:

The School of Art proposes to create a single concentration of Painting and Drawing. Currently, Painting and Drawing exist as separate concentration options. The school is combining them into one concentration, weaving these two areas together to address the redundancy of courses and strengthen the overall student experience. Painting and drawing are inextricably interwoven, and it is problematic to offer them as separate concentrations. Nationally, Painting and Drawing are offered as one concentration. In addition, with the launch Animation program we anticipate many students currently enrolled in the Drawing concentration will move to the Animation program.

Impact on other existing programs:

There is no impact on other majors or programs. This concentration is simply being combined with the Drawing concentration in the newly formed Painting and Drawing concentration.



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Impact on current students:

73 students are currently enrolled, with a Spring 2024 term for last graduates. Students will be advised to petition for courses substitutions. Most former required courses will still be offered as electives in the new major,
