# Briefly describe the rationale for disestablishment:

We discontinued enrollment in this certificate when the National Child Life organization starting requiring a Master's degree for certification in Child Life several years ago. They have since switched the requirements a number of times. We can no longer support the internship requirement for students to be eligible to take the certification exam. This is a jointly owned certificate, and the Watts College of Public Service and Community Solutions approves the disestablishment. Documentation of approval is included in this proposal.
