Rationale: The subcommittee requests that the revision address: regarding point 1, the ways that ENG 393 addresses specific aesthetics, values, and/or philosophies in the materials; regarding point 2, the specific ways that assignments engage in critical analysis of textual traditions; regrading point 3, the specific ways that assignments engage in critical analysis of artistic or design traditions; regarding point 4, demonstrates critical analysis of philosophical systems and/or aesthetic systems and values. Merely stating that the course asks the question, "What is literacy?" is not sufficient for our understanding of its qualifications for the HU designation.
