Discussion:

Charles Barbee from the University Senate Office attended CAPC to briefly discuss the new course review process with the committee. CAPC was tasked in previous years with the review and approval of new course proposals, but this is no longer the case.

In the past, the internal course review process was lengthy and multi-layered, but now the turnaround time has been dramatically reduced. Now, the senate approves a list of new courses monthly, and senators have access to Curriculum ChangeMaker. Senators can review course proposals and respond if there are questions and concerns.

Chuck also stated that the goal of the senate is to approve new curricular proposals within a first and second reading at senate meetings. There is a senate website that CAPC can access to contact a senator, if there is a question about a curricular proposal.
