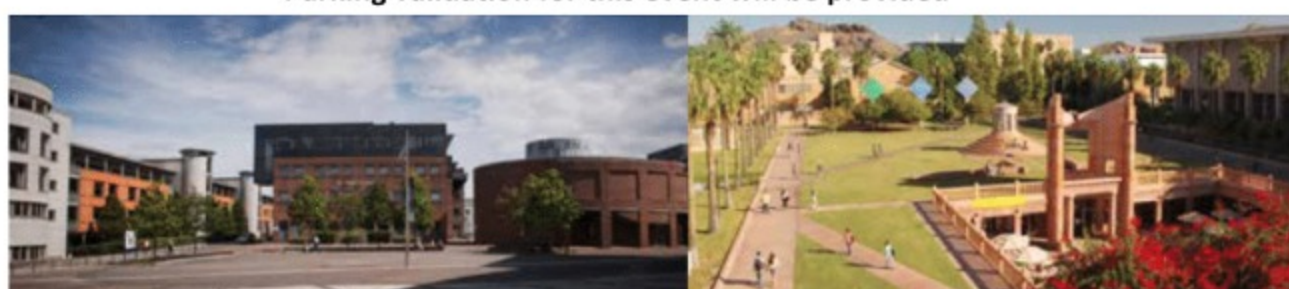

**Christine O'Kelly, MA**, has served as Dublin City University's Age Friendly University Coordinator since September of 2014. Throughout her career, she has worked with a range of agencies and networks engaged in enhancing the well-being of older adults. She is former CEO of Ireland's Older Women's Network, a global network with a focus on gender and aging and served as a board member of the National Women's Council and Banulacht, a national organization working with the developing world. Christine helped draft Ireland's National Positive Ageing Strategy, and investigated residential nursing homes that resulted in the establishment of a national watchdog agency on residential care. She is a member of the AGE Platform in the EU and is DCU's representative on the Dublin and Fingal Age-friendly Alliances and works on subgroups on housing and transport. Christine leads DCU's Age Friendly University initiative that has now expanded to 16 members globally. Ms. O'Kelly was educated at the National College of Ireland, Trinity College and DCU.
