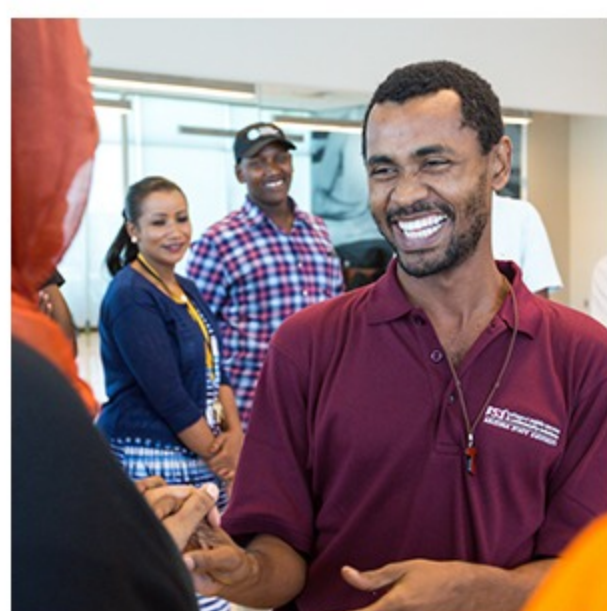
Community at ASU: Collaboration as a Driving Force

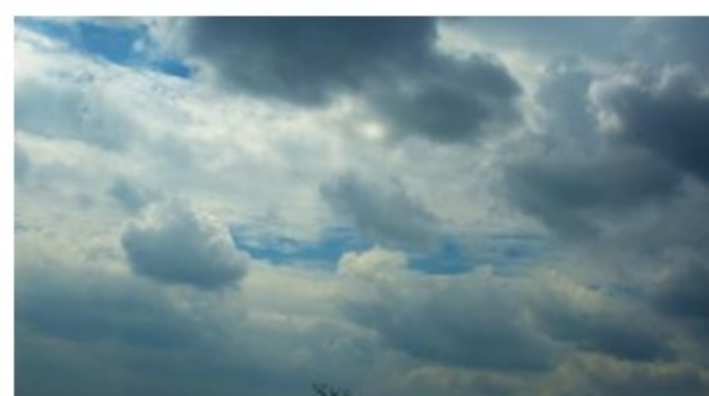
Awards and Recognition
