

Graduating Senior Report Card, 2015- 2016

The Graduating Senior Report Card (GSRC) is an annual survey of ASU students administered when they apply to graduate. The intent of the GSRC is to assess students' overall experiences at ASU, experiences in their major and general education courses, and plans for the future.

Student Service Related Summary Statements

- Belonging – Combination of strongly agree and agree responses
 - I feel that I belong at ASU: 88%
 - Other students are supportive: 91%
 - Administrative personnel/staff are helpful: 90%
- Nonacademic satisfaction – Combination of very satisfied and satisfied responses.
 - Social life on campus: 89%
 - Extracurricular speakers, cultural offerings, and events: 92%
 - Sense of community on campus: 83%
 - Recreational and intramural opportunities: 93%
 - Feeling of security on campus: 92%
- Learning Outcomes – Combination of very much and quite a bit responses.
 - Engaging with the community to address global and local issues: 64%
 - Creating and/or leading a new enterprise: 56%
 - Demonstrating social responsibility: 76%
 - Thinking creatively: 83%
- ASU Emphasis – Combination of very much and quite a bit responses.
 - ASU emphasizes providing the support needed to help students succeed academically: 80%
 - ASU emphasizes encouraging contact among students from different economic, social, and racial or ethnic background: 69%
 - ASU emphasizes helping students cope with non-academic responsibilities (work, family, etc.): 46%
 - ASU emphasizes providing the support students need to thrive socially: 58%
