## Approval Comments

<b>Outcome 1:</b>	<b>Demonstrate advanced knowledge of the core content areas in clinical mental health counseling: Helping Relationships, Group Work, Career Development, Research and Program Evaluation, Human Growth and Development, Cultural and Individual Diversity, Assessment, Professional Orientation and Ethical Practice.</b>
Measure 1.1:	All students must either: (a) take the Counselor Preparation Comprehensive Exam (CPCE) a national exam of counseling content included in licensing exams or (b) complete a master's thesis.
Performance Criterion 1.1:	80% of students will obtain a passing score on the CPCE on their first attempt, which is defined as exceeding the 35% of the national norms. 80% of students in the research option successfully defend their Master's thesis on the first try.
Measure 1.2:	Final project/paper in CPY 645 (Professional Issues and Ethics)
Performance Criterion 1.2:	80% of students will earn a rating of 80% or better on their final project/paper in CPY 645.
<b>Outcome 2:</b>	<b>Demonstrate counseling skills</b>
Measure 2.1:	Students will complete a 600-hour supervised counseling internship.
Performance Criterion 2.1:	80% of students will earn an overall rating of "Meets expectations" or "Exceeds Expectations" from their internship supervisors.
Measure 2.2:	All students will complete counseling practicum.
Performance Criterion 2.2:	80% of students will earn an overall rating of "Meets expectations" or "Exceeds Expectations" from their practicum supervisors.
