Arizona State University is committed to a positive workplace environment in which employees are respectful of each other and our students. ASU has an online training module to prevent discrimination and harassment.

All faculty, staff and student workers must complete this mandatory training.

The self-paced training takes about 90 minutes and can be completed in intervals. Information includes how to identify and prevent prohibited behavior, and where and how to report concerns. The module was developed by an organization that specializes in training for higher education.

- Supervisors must ensure all employees complete this training every two years.
- New hires must complete the training within 90 days of hire date.

Existing employees will receive an email invitation for the training.
